

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

Abstracts should be prepared in Microsoft Word with Time New Roman 12 font, single spacing and 1" margin on both sides. The abstract's thematic area must be clearly stated at the top of the page. The email address and phone number of the corresponding author must also be explicitly stated. Submit abstract as an email attachment to phrd.event@patanjali.res.in by 25th September, 2024. The acceptance of the abstract will be communicated to the corresponding author via email.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation

The participant should prepare the poster in advance and bring it in person. The dimensions of the poster should be $0.9 \, \mathrm{m}$ (width) x $1.2 \, \mathrm{m}$ (length).

Guidelines for Video Presentation

The participant must record 5 to 10 min video explaining his/her poster idea in clear audio-visual recording.
